Troy Community Farm 2017 Worker Share Application

Application Deadline: March 24, 2017

Worker shares will be notified of their selection by April 7, 2017.

Overview

- Worker shares are an essential part of our farm and make valuable contributions to our business. We could not do it without you!
- A worker share member trades labor for a CSA share. We have three types of worker share positions. All worker share members receive a standard CSA share for 21 weeks (see CSA membership information on our website) as well as access to the CSA u-pick flower and herb garden in exchange for their work on the farm or in our pizza business.
 - Filled up for 2017 Full Season Worker Shares work 5 hours per week starting the week of May 22nd and continuing through the week of October 16th. Full Season Worker Shares work one day per week on every Tuesday, Wednesday <u>OR</u> Friday from 7 AM 12 PM for the whole season. Orientations for these positions will be from 10 to 11 AM on Tuesday, May 16th, Wednesday May 17th or Friday May 19th depending on which shift you choose.
 - Filled up for 2017 Summer Worker Shares work 15 hours per week for seven weeks in the height of the season starting on June 20th and finishing on August 4th. Summer Worker Shares work three days per week every Tuesday, Wednesday, <u>AND</u> Friday from 7 AM to 12 PM. The summer orientation will be on Tuesday June 20th at 7:00 AM
 - **Pizza Worker Shares** work 9 hours per week for 12 weeks starting July 5th or 6th and finishing on September 21.
 - There are two shifts possibilities for pizza work:
 - Full day- Thursdays from 1pm-10pm
 - Prep shift- Wednesdays from 1pm-5pm (at FEED kitchen), Thursdays from 3:30pm-8:30pm

Orientation for pizza shares will be Thursday June 29 at 9am. This is a new worker share position so persons applying may need to be somewhat flexible for slight time changes.


- Particular tasks will change over the season, but will include planting, weeding, mulching, trellising, and harvesting. Friday worker shares will also have the opportunity to work in our sprout room on occasion.
- We provide detailed training on farm tasks. We expect worker shares to take instruction well, follow through with both accuracy and speed, and (because it takes practice to learn) to improve over time.
- Work on the farm is physically demanding and can be exhausting and repetitive. We work in all kinds of weather so it can also be hot, cold, windy, and wet. It can also be perfectly lovely from time to time.
- We start farm work at 7:00 AM. Timeliness is very important to us, so we suggest arriving 5-10 minutes early to allow for enough time to be ready to work at 7:00 AM. Late Policy: After 4 instances of being late, you will lose your worker share position.
- Vacation Policy: All worker shares can miss 2 days for vacation. Vacation plans should be submitted to Annali for approval.
- We value worker shares' opinions on what is included in weekly shares. When we have choices about what to harvest in a particular week, we will often ask for your input. We will also ask you to share your favorite recipes for the newsletter, if you are willing!
